Implant placement on models – Guided step-by-step implant placement on anatomical models using implant kits.

Hands-on Session 3:

Prosthetic components – Identification, sequencing, and hands-on assembly of restorative components.

Hands-on Session 4:

Records taken with Intraoral scanner – Capturing digital impressions, documentation, and practical use of the scanner.
